

IMPORTANT MAINTENANCE INFORMATION

YOU MUST LUBRICATE YOUR LOCKS EVERY MONTH


ENSURE YOU USE A LUBRICANT WHICH CONTAINS PTFE - NOT SILICON DON'T WAIT FOR LOCKS TO GET STIFF BEFORE LUBRICATING

Thank you for purchasing an Armaplate Challenger Hook Lock. You have invested in the best van security product on the market. Just like other parts of your vehicle, your new lock needs to be well maintained to ensure long and trouble-free operation.

We recommend that you spend a couple of minutes each month lubricating your locks using the techniques listed below. If you notice that the operation of your lock alters in any way (eg the lock gets stiffer) take remedial action straight away - don't allow it to become worse.

LUBRICATION METHOD:

- 1. USE A QUALITY PTFE LUBRICANT SUCH AS GT-85 (follow manufacturer's safety guidelines)
- 2. SHAKE THE CAN VIGOROUSLY
- 3. INSERT THE NOZZLE OF THE SPRAY CAN INTO THE CYLINDER'S KEYWAY IN 1sec BURSTS
- 4. RUN THE KEY IN AND OUT OF THE CYLINDER REPEATEDLY
- 5. REPEAT THE ABOVE UNTIL THE LOCK FEELS SMOOTH AGAIN
- 6. WIPE ANY RESIDUE FROM THE LOCK AND SURROUNDING AREA
- 7. IF THE CYCLINDER STILL FEELS STIFF TO OPERATE, YOUR KEY MAY BE WORN. RING US.



- 1. Your Name & Address
- 2. Your Vehicle Registration Number
- 3. A copy of your sales invoice (if purchased from a third party)
- 4. Your Key Code

If you fail to register within 7 days, your product will be covered by the standard 12 months cover. If you sell the vehicle, any extended guarantees will end. When making a claim, you may be asked to email a copy of your Registration Document. Guarantees are limited to replacement parts only and do not include any labour. Old parts must be returned to us when requested.

KEYS!

Your Armaplate Challenger Hook Lock comes with 3 keys. You <u>MUST</u> keep one of these keys stored safely away and treat it as your **MASTER KEY**. If one of your keys gets lost or damaged, get a new one cut immediately - never use a spare, leaving yourself with no backup!
